The plagiarism report indicates a 19% similarity index, with the first source (SBP Journal) contributing 4% and my paper appearing in the second source with 1% similarity. However, the first source also originates from my own work, as it has directly taken hypotheses from my paper, highlighted in red. The hypotheses marked in red are identical to mine. Although the report attributes this similarity to SBP, it is actually my original content, which includes 5% self-plagiarism. Excluding this 5%, the total plagiarism percentage is 14%.
